

Club Championships – 2nd Round Sunday, 23rd June 2024

Once again perfect weather greeted golfers for round 2 of the club championships and another day competition on Sunday. Just on 17 players got out there and made the most of the nice conditions.

In the day competition in A grade it was Tom Grigg who got the win with a score of 81-8-73. Just one ahead of runners up Scott Brady who had a score of 82-8-74.

In B grade Dom Leach had a win with a score of 102-29-73, runners up was Kevin Jones with 102-26-76. There was one nearest the pin and that was Don Hahnel on 16.

In the main event, the club championship, Tom Grigg has a 2 stroke lead over Scott Brady in A grade. Toms 81 has him on 165, Scotts 81 has him on 167.

B grade see's Ryan Monaghan leading the was, he had a 101 following his 93 last week, so that puts him on 194. Ricky Boyd has slipped into second with another 98 following his 98 from last week, so that has him on 196, 2 shots behind Ryan. Nick Vine slips back to third with a 101 this week, 197 overall, 3 shots off the lead, then it's Dallas Plant just 3 shots further back on 200, 6 shots off the lead.

In C grade Gil Grace is the new leader Gil had 104, following his 101 last week which puts him on 205, Trent Crook has dropped back to second with 108 this week following his 99 last week giving him 207, 2 shots behind Gil. Dom Leach is next best with 210, his 102 has given him a chance.

In the JK Monaghan handicap event Tom Grigg leads the way with 149, Nick Vine is one behind on 150, Scott Brady and Gill Grace are right behind him on 151, Dom Leach 152, then Dallas Plant 153. So it's a tight race to see who can get their name up in gold.

So this Sunday is the final round of the club championships, should be a fascinating day with all 3 grades, and the JK Monaghan very close. Once again there will be a day competition. Assembly will be 11.30 for a midday start..
